

² **H&I Commitments:** A commitment is held by individual members of the H&I Subcommittee. If you have one panel leader going into ABC facility every Monday at 7pm, that is 1 commitment. If you have two panel leaders splitting the commitment and alternating bi-weekly, that is 2 commitments. If you have a panel of four people who jointly cover a presentation (i.e., for a jail possibly), that would be 4 commitments. You count the number of slots that can be held by an individual.
